Jan. 1, 2018	FIRST DAY to apply for a ballot by mail. Even though Jan 1 is a holiday, the beginning date for the action does not change.	County Election Administrator
Jan. 17, 2018	FIRST DAY for filing Application For A Place On The Ballot. FIRST DAY for filing Declaration Of Write-In Candidacy.	File with City Secretary
Feb. 16, 2018	LAST DAY for filing Application For A Place On The Ballot. (Must be received by 5 p.m. City Secretary's Office doors lock sharply at 5 p.m. and applications will not be accepted.) STATUTORY LAST DAY FOR ORDERING ELECTION AND DESIGNATING VOTING PRECINCTS.	File with City Secretary Mayor
Feb. 20, 2018	LAST DAY for a Write-In Candidate to declare candidacy in the General and/or Special Election. (Must be received by 5 p.m.)	File with City Secretary
Feb. 23 2018	LAST DAY for a Candidate in the General Election to withdraw. (Withdrawal request must be received by 5 p.m.) LAST DAY that a Declaration of Ineligibility causes omission of candidate's name from ballot. (These deadlines occur on the 5 th day after the filing deadline. Must be received by 5 p.m.)	File with City Secretary File with City Secretary

Feb. 23, 2018	LAST DAY for a Write-In Candidate to withdraw in General Election and have name removed from write-in list. (The statute does not state a time so the deadline is midnight.)	File with City Secretary

Canvass cannot happen until after the EVBB submits Early Voting tabulation to Election Administrator for certification and returns to City Secretary. The next regular City Council Meeting and probable Canvass date is May 15, 2018. A Special Called Canvass Meeting may be necessary on Wednesday, May 16, 2018)	Mayor Council City Secretary
